**SUBJECT: Discussion and direction to staff on No Parking Zone at Traffic Control Devices.**

---

**1. BACKGROUND/HISTORY**

The City of Buda has been contacted concerning adequate clearances for vehicles traveling on residential streets as well as at street corners.

**2. FINDINGS/CURRENT ACTIVITY**

City staff met to discuss possible options for improving maneuverability on city streets.

One of the options discussed was to create a no parking zone a minimum of 20 feet from an unmarked crosswalk.

Public Works marked the curb using this dimension at an intersection in Cullen Country to provide an example of the potential impact at the intersection as well as the potential impact to the residents. A copy of these photos is provided in the attached PowerPoint presentation.

**3. FINANCIAL IMPACT**

Public Works estimates it would cost \$20.00 for materials to paint the No Parking Zones at each intersection with a traffic control device. There are approximately 221 intersections in the city limits. The total estimated cost for painting the intersections is \$4,420 for materials.

**4. ACTION OPTIONS/RECOMMENDATION**

Staff is asking City Council to provide direction for creating a No Parking Zone at Traffic Control Devices.
